1981: Before Leaving Germany Begin Writing a Proposal for Submission to the OAU at UN in NY

Proposal Titled: "Reshaping Scientific Technology to Meet the Needs of Developing African Countries"

<u>1981-1984</u>

Formed my First Corporation called "Infrasurface, Inc." Completed Proposal and Submitted it to OAU. Began to Serve as a Consultant to the United Nations Development Program (UNDP). Task: Travel to Africa (2x) to Assist Scientist with Writing Proposals for Submission to World Bank (WB), The International Monetary Fund (IMF), and U.S. Agency for International Development (USAID).

<u>1984-1988</u>

Became a Visiting Scientist in the **Chemistry Department at Howard** University to further refine and shape the vision. Gave a talk to USAID. Was instructed to visit USDA-ARS in Peoria, IL. Following visit, submitted a proposal to **USAID** based on information received from USDA-ARS. USAID awarded funds to implement a collaborative research project with a university in Nigeria.





- No matter how enticing the American way of life became, he was to return to Nigeria to continue and expand the food research




THE GREAT DAWN OF HISTORY
